

Have Got

Explanation of "Have Got"

In English:

"Have got" is used to express possession, relationships, or characteristics. It's common in British English and informal contexts.

- **Structure:** Subject + **have/has** + **got** + object.
 - Example: *She has got a red bike.*
- **Negation:** Add **not** after **have/has** → *haven't/hasn't got*.
- **Questions:** Invert **have/has** and the subject → *Have you got a pen?*

In French:

French uses **avoir** (to have) for possession, without a direct equivalent of "have got."

- **Structure:** Subject + **avoir** + object.
 - Example: *Elle a un vélo rouge.*
- **Negation:** **ne** + **avoir** + **pas** + **de** (replaces "un/une/des").
- **Questions:** Use inversion (*As-tu...?*) or **Est-ce que** (*Est-ce que tu as...?*).
